

Full-Time Nights – Crisis Assessment Worker

The Youth Emergency Shelter Society is looking for a permanent full-time Crisis Assessment Worker for the Emergency Shelter Program.

The Shelter Program provides a service for youth that require a safe place to stay. The Shelter Program further addresses the need to provide a safe place to sleep at night and a nutritious meal. Trained staff connect with youth and provide them resources and support to make positive lifestyle changes.

Duties: Include conducting assessments and intakes along with providing care and supervision of clients. Some light housekeeping are required as part of positive role modeling. Maintaining a safe living environment and ensuring all program expectations are met as well as other related duties are also an essential component of this position.

Hours of Work: 12-hr night shifts on a rotating schedule based on a 40 hr work week.

Qualifications: Working towards or have completed Diploma/Degree in Child and Youth Care or related Human services. Must have valid driver's license, First Aid/CPR and Suicide Intervention Certificate. Criminal Record Check and Intervention Check must be less than six months old. Must be knowledgeable and respectful of the cultural values, beliefs and practices of the Aboriginal culture. Previous experience is desirable.
