The Program

Our wide range of local programs and services includes supported independent and semi independent living, behaviour consultation, mental health and physical care.

The Position

The Overnight Community Disability Support Worker, working 32-40 hrs/wk, (7pm - 7am), is a front-line role who assists persons with complex needs, mental health concerns, and/or developmental disabilities to live in and actively participate in their community. During overnight hours they ensure a consistent, healthy and safe environment for the persons in care and are available to provide immediate support in crisis situations. In the event of an emergent situation sleep staff will be responsible for awake responsibilities. This position reports to an assigned Team Leader.

In Your Role You Will

- Implement person-centered plans designed to provide instruction, guidance and assistance in a helpful and supportive manner
- Support individual with their personal life planning and goal setting and achievement.
- Assist individuals to develop personal home living skills, assisting with direct care of individual when required.
- Maximize participation/inclusion at home and in the community and minimize risks in the client`s physical, social and recreational environments .
- Model socially appropriate behaviours (for the individual and the community).
- Work with minimal supervision on an interdisciplinary team and cooperate with team members to solve problems, resolve conflicts and make decisions.
- Administer medical administration or first aid, according to prescribed procedures.
- Collect information; prepare maintain, edit, and organize correspondence, Individual service plans, and progress reports; maintain files according to agency, ministry and accreditation standards.

- Participate in shift exchanges, staff communication and communication of issues or concerns.
- Maintain required documentation.

***** Prior to confirmation of employment all applicants must provide a current (dated within 3 months of hiring date) Criminal Record Check and Ministry Check. These checks can take up to 6 weeks to obtain, please ensure you prepare accordingly.**

- CPR/First Aid & Abuse Protocol training (if necessary, will consider providing training)
