Details: In this position you will be responsible for delivering the Positive Parenting Program to parents/guardians receiving support from the Family Support and Respite Program. The successful candidate will use simple and practical strategies which can be adapted to suit individual family values, beliefs and needs.

Hours: Flexibility is required as shift times and hours will depend on the needs of the families. Hours will include weekdays, weekends, and some early evenings.
