Edmonton's Family Intervention Services Program Requires:

FAMILY TIME COACHES

Details: Family Time Coaches will provide fully engaging supervised and/or supported visits with children, siblings and their parents/caregivers. This service provides the opportunity for the children to be picked up from their current residence and transported by vehicle to a scheduled visitation location in the community. While in the vehicle, the Coach will utilize appropriate early childhood development activities to build a relationship with children and support their development during the transition to and from the visitation with the parents/guardians. During the visits the Family Time Coaches will support the reunification process by planning and interacting with families to work towards the goals that have been set. Supportive learning opportunities may also be provided by demonstration and modeling around children's brain development and functioning, promoting healthy child development, family dynamics and communication.

Hours: We are currently looking to hire Full Time, Part Time and Casual Family Time Coaches:

- ◆ **Full Time Family Coach**— 40 hours per week; benefits included
 - ◆ **Part Time Family Coach**—22 hours per week; benefits included

- ◆ Organizational skills and ability to prioritize

- ◆ Working knowledge of MS Office, with experience in Excel and database systems
